


Eco Club are taking part in a project for clean air pollution. We have put some monitors outside of school which we will look at and take readings from at the end of four weeks!














A big thank you to Friends of Church Drive for our new grrenhouse and planters. We have started adding seeds now. Hopefully we will see them flourish in the coming months!
