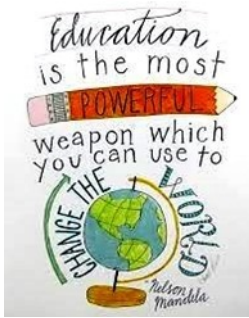

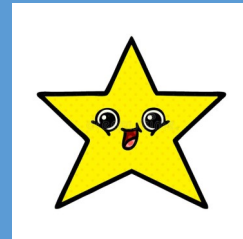

Juniper—Annabelle W—For fabulous ideas in English

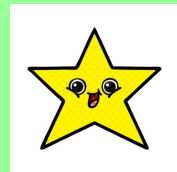
