Attendance update

In order to provide all our pupils a future that is filled with choice and opportunity we need to ensure they are in school regularly and punctually. There is a clear link between attendance at school and academic achievement. Statistically, those with higher than 96% attendance achieve higher levels of attainment at EYFS, Key Stage 1, Key Stage 2 and beyond to GCSE and A levels.

We therefore put attendance and punctuality high on our list of priorities for children and families and have set our target for attendance at 97%. It is essential that children come to school every day and on time so they can make the best possible progress in their learning.

Some risk of underachievement
Depending on context and understanding of the absence, a letter will be sent home

AMBER

Serious risk of underachievement
Phone calls to parent/carers and meetings to offer support

RED

Extreme risk of underachievement
Meetings with parents/carers and the Local Authority attendance officer
Potential for penalty notices to be issued

Punctuality

We believe in consistent good punctuality and ask parents and carers to make every effort to get their children to school on time each day.

The school gates open at 8:40am until 8:50am and the children are allowed to go to class and be ready to begin their learning for 8:55am.

Arrivals after 9:30 are marked as an unauthorised absence (U) and count as being absent for the whole AM session.

Absence due to Illness

If your child is unwell and cannot attend school, please either call the school office absence line to leave a message, or send an in-App Arbor message before 8.30am to give a reason for absence. Failure to inform the school about your child's absence will result in an unauthorised absence mark in the register. Children who have frequent occasional days off due to illness may be referred to Education Welfare.
