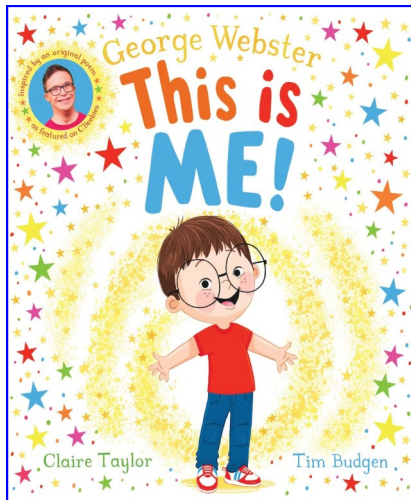

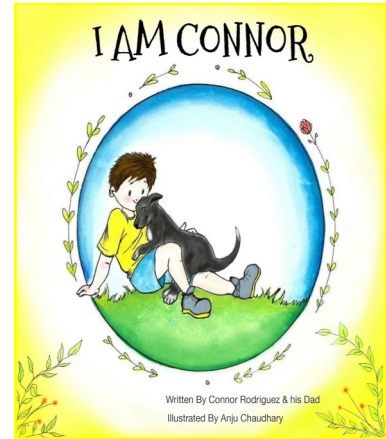
DOWN SYNDROME AWARENESS MONTH— OCTOBER 2023
