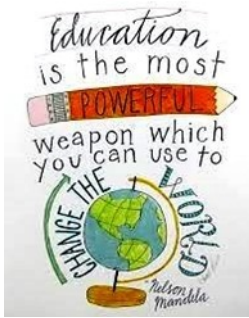

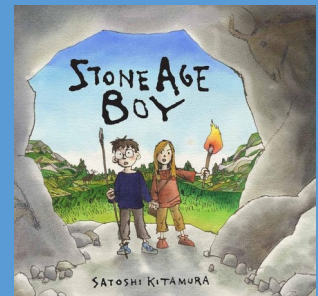
Headteacher Message
