Headteacher Message

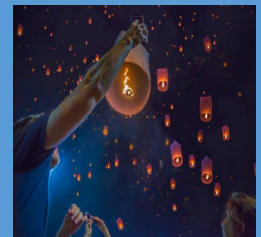
